

Doctor Profile Orthopaedic Surgeon Hip, Knee & Shoulder

Professor Phong Tran MBBS, FRACS, FAOrthA



Phong completed his undergraduate training at Monash University in 1999 and completed his training in orthopaedic surgery in 2007. In 2009, he undertook specialist fellowship training at orthopaedic centres in Germany specialising in sports injury, shoulder and arthroscopic surgery. During 2010 he continued his fellowship training specialising in hip arthroscopy and muscle-sparing anterior hip replacement.

Professor Phong Tran is the Head of the Orthopaedic Department at Western Health. He is an adjunct Professor at both Victoria and Swinburne Universities. Additionally, he holds an honorary clinical associate professor at Melbourne University and is a program director at the Australian Institute of Musculoskeletal Science.

Phong performs arthroplasty and arthroscopic surgery to the hip, knee and shoulder. Some of his techniques include the anterior approach hip replacement, subvastus approach with kinematic alignment for knee replacements, reverse shoulder replacements with computer navigation and knee arthroscopy with radiofrequency ablation.
