Dr. Stewart Morrison is an Australian orthopaedic surgeon with interests in hip and knee replacement, limb reconstruction, deformity correction, and bone tumour management. He treats both adult and paediatric patients.

Dr. Morrison earned his MBBS from Monash University in 2008 and became a Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons (FRACS) in 2018. He pursued advanced training in limb reconstruction and joint replacement at the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis, USA, as well as in paediatric orthopaedics in Stuttgart, Germany.

Based in Melbourne, he holds consultant roles at The Royal Children's Hospital, Alfred Health, and private practices at St Vincent's Private Hospital, Epworth Richmond, and Adeney Private Hospital in Kew.

Dr Morrison also runs a research program focussing on paediatric limb deformity, holds multiple publications and participates regularly in international presentations.

Dr. Morrison is actively involved in medical advocacy and professional organisations, including the Australian Orthopaedic Association. Outside of surgery, he enjoys travel, live music, and architectural photography.
